

Delta looking to add 2 Japan flights

Delta Air Lines seeks to add flights from Japan to Honolulu and Palau

ATLANTA (AP) -- Delta Air Lines Inc. said on Friday that it will seek to add flights between Honolulu and Nagoya, Japan, and between Tokyo and the island of Palau.

Both flights will connect Japan with popular leisure destinations in the Pacific.

Delta said it would start daily service between Nagoya and Honolulu on Dec. 22 if it gets government approval. It said it would use Boeing 767-300ER aircraft with 216 seats for the flights.

Delta said it had applied with the U.S. Transportation Department to start four-times-a-week flights between Narita airport in Tokyo, where Delta has a hub, and Palau.

Delta Air Lines shares fell 85 cents, or 7.3 percent, to \$10.87 in afternoon trading.

Delta-Northwest merger: One-way ticket to new unions?

FORTUNE -- Since 1926 the Railway Labor Act has allowed airline and railroad employees to vote on whether to unionize. But for years there was a quirky detail that worked in management's favor: All abstentions were counted as "no" votes. That changed last fall, when the National Mediation Board, with two new members appointed by President Obama, proposed changing the rules to count only votes that were cast -- and make no assumptions about abstentions.

After a relatively rapid court skirmish, last Friday, Judge Paul Friedman upheld the rule change against the wishes of the Air Transportation Association, an industry advocate. That means that starting today, union leaders can target firms with the greatest number of non-unionized workers, and

they have already filed this morning for a vote at the most obvious target: Delta Air Lines (DAL, Fortune 500).

Northwest Airlines union seeks vote at Delta

Union covering former Northwest Airlines workers asks for vote at Delta

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) -- The union for thousands of ground workers at the old Northwest Airlines says it will ask for a vote at Delta, now that election rules have been changed in a way that favors the union.

The union for baggage handlers and passenger service workers is asking the National Mediation Board to find that Delta and Northwest are operating as a single carrier. The two airlines got a single operating certificate from the government on Dec. 31.

Most of the former Northwest workers are unionized. At Delta, pilots were the only large group with a union.

The old rule required a majority of the entire work force to favor unionizing. That meant workers who didn't vote were effectively counted as "no" votes. The rule change took effect on Thursday.

Delta sells Mesaba, Compass for \$83M

Delta Air Lines Inc. will sell two of its regional carriers -- Mesaba and **Compass Airlines** -- for \$82.5 million.

The Atlanta-based carrier said it sold Mesaba to Memphis, Tenn.-based Pinnacle Airlines Corp. (NASDAQ: PNCL) for \$62 million. It sold Compass to St. Louis-based Trans States Holdings Inc. for \$20.5 million.

Mesaba and Compass will continue as Delta Connection carriers, serving Delta (NYSE: DAL) customers with long-term, extendable agreements, ranging from seven to 12 years depending on aircraft type.

The transactions are not expected to cause changes in flight schedules or locations served, Delta said. Compass and Mesaba's combined fleet of nearly 130 aircraft will continue to be dedicated to flying Delta routes.

Mesaba has more than 430 flights each day to 95 airports, while Compass has more than 170 flights each day to 35 airports.

Both Mesaba and Compass will keep Minneapolis-St. Paul headquarters, with current presidents John Spanjers and Tim Campbell, respectively, leading the airlines under new ownership.

"Today's announcement reflects our continued focus on streamlining the portfolio of Delta Connection carriers serving our customers to ensure each partner airline is independently positioned for success with a competitive cost structure and an

industry-leading focus on safety, reliability and customer service," said Delta Connection Senior Vice President Don Bornhorst, in a statement. "... This transaction is another step in positioning our regional airlines for future success and we look forward to delivering even more improvements to customers in the more than 260 communities our partners serve."

American Air parent claims worker data compromised

American Airlines parent: information of 79K retired, former and current workers compromised

FORT WORTH, Texas (AP) -- The parent company of American Airlines says the personal information of about 79,000 retirees, former and current employees that was held by the company's pension department has been compromised.

No customer data was affected. AMR says the breach happened when a hard drive was stolen from its headquarters in Fort Worth, Texas.

The data spans a period from 1960 to 1995. The drive contained images of historical microfilm files, which included names, addresses, dates of birth, Social Security numbers, and possibly some bank account information. Some health insurance information may have also been included.

AMR is offering one year of free credit monitoring for those affected.

- 5. Final Benefit Determination Letters (BDL's) PBGC re-calc "determination" of qualified annuity (likely after claim stock sale) pending (only 45 days to appeal)
- 6. Pension reinstatement/contribution request by DP3 representing the retired pilots. very long shot....pending
- 7. Roth IRA creation as per Worker, Retiree, and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 deadline June 22nd, 2009
- 8. Expiration of HCTC 80% premium subsidy will expire on December 31, 2010. Back to 65%.

Boehner Suggests Social Security Cuts

- 1) Now, no one has to wait until age 70 to receive their full benefit, but...
- 2) House Minority Leader John Boehner, R-Ohio, suggested ways to reform Social Security...
 - (a) Raise the retirement age to 70 for people who are still at least 20 years away from retirement.
 - (b) Replacing the wage inflation adjustment with the more slowly-growing price inflation adjustment.
- (c) Imposing *means testing*. People with other sources of income in retirement would see their Social Security retirement benefits reduced.
- 3) Now, full benefits are available to retirees before age 70.
- 4) Boehner's statement is not a formal proposal, yet, but may indicate a future move in that direction.

New yield fare calculator available on TravelNet

Delta's Pass Travel team has introduced a new yield fare calculator for travel companions, nondependent children and some furloughed employees and their family members who travel on these fares.

The new self-service tool, available on TravelNet, can more accurately display the total fare, which includes the base fare and applicable taxes based on the planned itinerary, compared to the previous calculator that provided only point-to-point base fares.

Similar to the buddy pass fare calculator on TravelNet, users now will be able to use the yield fare calculator to choose exact flight routings, including stopovers, to provide the base fare and approximate taxes.

More Delta people will soon be eligible for the popular Fly Confirmed for Even Less Program

June 25, 2010

Eligibility for the popular Fly Confirmed for Even Less Program is expanding. Pass-eligible retirees and survivors, as well as parents of eligible employees and retirees, will be able to purchase confirmed tickets with an even greater discount than the 20% offered through the standard Fly Confirmed program once technology upgrades are implemented later this year. Additional restrictions and penalties apply to the Even Less program for everyone who uses it.

"When we reinstated the Fly Confirmed for Even Less program in January, we used the same eligibility criteria of the former Northwest program which, unfortunately, excluded retirees and survivors. It was not our intention to exclude these groups and once we were alerted of this omission we began looking at a technology solution to open up this program to more Delta people," said Rob Kight, v.p. - Compensation, Benefits & Services. "Retirees told us that having an additional, confirmed travel program to help them fly during peak holiday periods or to important family events without worrying about passenger bookings was important to them."
