2011 Voluntary Program Statistics

With the recent closure of Delta's 2011 Voluntary Programs, your Delta MEC Retirement & Insurance Committee thought you might be interested in the demographics of those pilots electing one of the two programs. In summary, 163 pilots elected retirement under the 55-point program, and two pilots elected to separate from Delta under the Early Out program. See the tables and charts below for a further breakdown of this data. Flight Operations has not yet determined whether an Advance Entitlement bid will be necessary as a direct result of the attrition due to these retirements/separations.
